

Details about Academic Programmes

- The B.A./B.Sc (Honours and General) Programmes will be of six semester duration.
- Six semesters will be in three years.
- Each semester will consists of 15-18 weeks of academic year equivalent to 90 actual teaching days. Odd Semester (i.e. 1st, 3rd and 5th semesters) is from July to December and Even Semester (i.e. 2nd , 4th and 6th semesters) is from January to June.
- An undergraduate Degree with Honours in Arts /Science shall be awarded if a student completes 14 core courses/papers in that discipline, 2 Ability Enhancement Compulsory Courses (AECC), 2 Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC), 4 courses/papers from a list of Discipline Specific Elective (DSE) and 4 courses/papers from a list of Generic Elective(GE) papers, respectively.
- An undergraduate General Degree in Science shall be awarded if a student completes 12 core courses/papers (4 core papers each in three discipline of choice) , 2 Ability Enhancement Compulsory Courses(AECC), 4 skill Enhancement Courses(SEC) and 2 papers each from a list of Discipline Specific Elective (DSE) papers based on three discipline of choice selected above, respectively.
- An undergraduate General Degree in Arts shall be awarded if a student completes 12 Core Courses (4 core papers each in two discipline of choice, 2 core papers each in English and MIL respectively), 2 Ability Enhancement compulsory Course (AECC), 4 Skill Enhancement Course (SEC), 2 papers each from a list of Discipline Specific Elective (DSE) papers based on the two discipline of choice selected above respectively, and 2 papers from the Generic Elective (GE).
- A candidate (Honours/ General) shall have to complete each semester examination within 3 (Three) consecutive chances including his / her first appearance in the concerned End Semester Examination
- All arrear papers from 1st semester to 5th semester must be cleared before being promoted to 6th semester.

RULES OF DISCIPLINE

The college expects its students to conduct themselves in a disciplined and dignified manner in the college and outside. For this some provisions are as follows :

1. College uniform for all students is compulsory.
2. Students shall obey an order issued by the University or by the Principal of the college.
3. Students shall conduct themselves in a gentle manner both towards the members of the staff and towards their fellow students.
4. Students shall maintain perfect silence in class rooms and library room and desist from demonstration or disorderly behavior. They must not loiter in the corridors or in front of the class rooms, office or library rooms and must keep as quiet as possible during the college hours.
5. Students shall not misappropriate, destroy, mutilate, disfigure or damage any college or university property, in particular library books, laboratory equipment, furniture, apparatus etc.
6. No student suffering from any contagious or infectious disease will be permitted to attend the college.
For a breach of discipline within or outside the premises of the college, the Principal of the college may.

- i) Impose a fine on students, and/or
- ii) Suspend the students for a definite period, or
- iii) Expel him from the college for such a period as he thinks it fit.

The Principal may ask a student to leave the college if he considers such action necessary in the interest of institution or may bring such matters of grave nature to the notice of the Governing Body for a decision without assigning any reason for that.

ATTENDANCE

It is obligatory on part of the students to attend classes regularly and punctually. Willful absence from the class room lecture will be treated as a serious infringement of college discipline. As a rule each student is required to attend minimum 75% of the total lectures delivered in each subject in a semester as per the CBCS norms of Vidyasagar University.
